Community Resident Advisors (CRAs) play an integral role in the quality of the living experience at our Student Family Housing complex located on Buena Vista Avenue.

CRAs are live-in staff members that are required to live in the Student Family Housing (SFH) complex for the entire academic year. Their primary duties include the following:

- Actively build their assigned SFH community
- Develop, implement, and evaluate community programs designed to support students and their families
- Communicate with department staff & community members regarding important information
- Respond to community needs — including mediations, disciplinary actions, safety concerns, etc.
- Assist in department projects, events, and initiatives

The CRA position services a unique population of diverse students and their family members. SFH CRAs have the opportunity to work with students from around the world.
