



# Student Hall Directors



SHDs play an integral role in the mission of Res Life & Student Housing by creating conditions within the on-campus residence halls that allow a diverse student population to live and learn in a comfortable, non-threatening environment.

SHDs are live-in staff members that are required to live in the University residence halls for the entire academic year. Their primary duties include the following:

- Participate as a member of the Resident Education Senior Staff Team; oversee a community of approx. 200 residents
- Directly supervise 3-4 Resident Advisors
- Lead community development and programmatic efforts within their assigned residence hall
- Respond to community needs — including disciplinary actions and safety concerns
- Assist in department projects, events, and initiatives

- Communicate with other department members, constituents, and residence hall community members



The SHD position is one of the most advanced student positions within Residence Life & Student Housing. Student Hall Directors have the opportunity to develop managerial and supervisory skills and to contribute significantly to the on-campus living experience.

If you are interested in becoming a SHD, we encourage you to:

- Live on-campus and work toward becoming a RA
- Actively participate in your campus community
- Demonstrate excellent academic and work performance

Student Hall Director recruitment begins around January-February of each year.

Student Hall Directors are compensated with a \$650 monthly stipend and a free residence hall room for the academic year.
